Article 6,7(b) Thirty Day Displacement Rule:

Engineers having served (30) thirty consecutive days on the same assignment, desiring to displace a junior engineer not in the same pool may do so by making a written request to the Crew Management Center, with copy to the (BLET) Local Chairman. The Engineer's assignment that is being vacated will be bulletined and the engineer making the displacement will remain on the assignment during the bulletin period. The engineer making such a displacement will remain on the assignment he displaces to for not less than (30) thirty days, unless the assignment is abolished, re-bulletined, or he otherwise acquires displacement rights under the applicable rules. Engineers making such a displacement or other effected engineers will not be paid deadhead payment(s) as a result of such a seniority move.
