Train 159 Lynchburg to Linwood:

Trains will operate with three pools, LB01-LB02-LB03. Crews assigned in this service will be in place to accept a call between 5:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. When train is not operated within this calling window, crews will be deadheaded to Lynchburg and will receive a basic day.


Crews assigned in this service will be placed on duty at Lynchburg on their rest or within 14 hours of off duty time. In the event crews are not on called on duty within the 14 hours, crews will be paid 8 Hours.

If for any reason trains 158/159 are operated as an extra, i.e. M-symbol, and the regular train has not operated or has been changed account of holiday or other legitimate reason, the assigned crews will protect the train.


Either party may cancel this understanding by giving Fifteen (15) days written notice.
